Re: Sahuarita Landfill Service Continuation

The Town of Sahuarita Mayor and Council approved waiving, for at least one year, the Town's receipt of ten percent of the County's expected revenues at the Sahuarita Landfill. Such will significantly reduce the projected facility operating deficit. Based on this action, I have allocated up to \$200,000 of the Solid Waste deficit budget stabilization set aside to operate the Sahuarita Landfill for the 2010/11 fiscal year.

I have asked Environmental Quality Director Ursula Kramer to remove any signage regarding closure of the Sahuarita Landfill for next year. The action of the Sahuarita Mayor and Council, as well as the Board of Supervisors' approval of the budget containing revenues to offset the probable Solid Waste deficit, will allow the landfill to operate for another year.

Staff and I are very appreciative of the cooperation that has been extended to the County by the Mayor and Council and staff of the Town of Sahuarita.
